Diapers Needed

At Gill Children's Services one of the resources we regularly supply to Tarrant County families is disposable diapers. Last year 143 babies and toddlers received free diapers from Gill with a value of \$2,706. Mothers can pick up diapers, size newborn through pull-ups (1-6), once every three months, if needed.

- 1 in 3 mothers have had to choose between diapers and basic needs like food.
- Moms struggling with diaper need are likely to keep their babies out of daycare, which requires a full day's supply of diapers.
- 2% of mothers have had to reuse soiled diapers.

Gill Children's Services is a funding source of last resort that provides a safety net for Tarrant County Children whose medical, dental, physical, social, psychological and educational needs have not been met by other community resources.

Gill Children's Services, in partnership with the Children's Oral Health Coalition of Cook Children's Medical Center, helped assemble thousands of oral health kits. The kits contain a toothbrush, toothpaste, and information about oral hygiene; they will be distributed to children ages Pre-K through 3rd grade in Tarrant County. Gill's Board Members spent their lunch hour in an assembly line. Gill Co-Founder Mrs. Ginny Richards, 89, stuffed the bags with toothpaste.

Your Gift at Work

At Gill Children's Services 100% of every donated dollar goes directly to Tarrant County children in need. Last year it cost \$262 to provide a critical service such as hearing aids, root canals, medications, summer school tuition, diapers, and much more.

So far this year, Gill has served 960 local children, a record high since 2011. With needs for dental and educational services on the rise, we anticipate serving more kids than ever.

With every decade, Gill has experienced different needs in the community. This past year, we tracked a

- 142% increase in dental anesthesia and facility fee cases
- 11% increase in summer school tuition cases
- 85% increase in eye exam and surgery cases • 26% decrease in special equipment clients

To keep costs manageable, Gill works with a number of trusted local service providers. Dentists, pediatricians, audiologists, retailers, etc. give Gill Children's Services a reduced or pro bono rate, allowing precious resources to go further. Because of these strong relationships, this year's price per service has decreased from \$262 to \$208, allowing us to serve more children per dollar.
